The Program

The Soccer Concentration Program takes place during the school day. Soccer courses are part of the students' timetable. Throughout the 9-day cycle the Secondary 3 and 5 students will be receiving 6×75 minute periods and the Secondary 4 students 5×75 minute periods.

That being said, only the students in the Soccer Concentration Program will benefit from extra training, extra technical coaching extra activities, extra periods of Physical Education (soccer) and possible field trips.

Code of Conduct

Prior to final acceptance into the soccer Concentration Program, students and parents will be required to sign a contract agreeing to accept the responsibilities, expectations and conduct as outlined in the contract.

If the student doesn't respect the contract, they will be placed on probation. Parents will be notified in writing by the administration.

If the student doesn't show improvement within a certain time period during the probation (designed by the administration) then that student will be asked to leave the program. Please note that if the student is removed from the program, their schedule and teachers can be subject to change.

Important note: A student can also be removed from the program without probation depending on the severity of their situation (i.e. severe behavioral insubordination or poor academics in multiple core subjects).

Concentration Fees

In addition to regular school fees, a soccer concentration fee will be charged to cover the additional cost of purchase of specialized coaching, workshops, health services, participation in games, transport, uniform. All fees are subject to the approval of the Governing Board.
