Theatre Concentration

The Program

Laval Senior Academy's Theatre Concentration is a program in which students:

- Learn to step outside their comfort-zones.
- Build confidence.
- Develop improvisational skills.
- Participate in workshops led by guest speakers.
- Attend theatre productions on field trips.
- Prepare for Creative Arts, Literature & Languages (CALL) and Professional Theatre programs at the CEGEP level (e.g.: Dawson College & John Abbott College).

Theatre Concentration students meet for class 5 to 6 days out of the school cycle of 9 days. One major production is performed in late April/early May of each school year, and students participate in regular after-school play practices in preparation for it.

Students participate in one of two main streams within the program – Acting Stream and Technical Crew.

Acting

Students participating in the "Acting" stream perform on stage as actors, singers and dancers. Students interested in choreographing dance routines and directing are given the opportunity to practice these skills while preparing for our annual production.

Technical Crew

Students applying to the "Tech" stream must be willing to work hard and to get their hands dirty. The Tech Crew is responsible for designing, building and painting sets for our plays and musicals. Being a member of the Tech Crew involves working with tools, paint, lighting, sound, props, costumes, etc.
